Price Details

The above ECC 2005 Prices include the following for every ECC 2005 yacht:

- a. safety equipment including GPS, VHF radio, lifejackets, safety harnesses, lifebuoy, flares and signal rockets, fire extinguisher, torch and batteries, first aid kits, electronic log and echo sounder, barometer, main and hand bearing compass, tool box, charts, dividers, pencils and erasers, binoculars and cruising notes and / or pilot book; and
- b. inflatable or rigid bottom dinghy; and
- c. full brief for each skipper and crew on the yachts systems and safety equipment; and
- d. linen, including sheets and pillows, quilts or blankets and towels (not beach towels); and
- e. galley and domestic equipment including minimum two burner stove and grill and / or oven, crockery and cutlery, cooking utensils, food containers, tea towels, cleaning materials, dustpan and brush, toilet paper (1 per head), two sets of masks, snorkels and fins and FM Radio / Compact Disc Player; and
- f. other Sunsail standard equipment like cockpit shower, swimming ladder and outboards; and
- g. cleaning of the yachts before and after the ECC 2005; and
- h. all marina fees, mooring fees, local taxes and Kornati National Park fees for each yacht and each skipper / crew member; and
- i. fuel for the ECC 2005.

Deposit

The deposit for every ECC 2005 yacht will be 3.000 EUR.

Application Form

Chartering Process

The Sunsail website is currently being prepared by Sunsail. The full address and the password will be provided to each skipper with the preliminary confirmation of registration on 11.10.2004, i.e. no charter contracts for the yachts can be finalised before that date. Please do not contact Sunsail before that date, because (i) they will be waiting for our list of registered participants and (ii) everyone should have the same chance of securing the - in her / his opinion - most competitive boat by starting the chartering process on the same date for every participant.

Date of the ECC 2005

We acknowledge that the ECC 2005 will take place right before Pentecost. However as there are several holiday seasons and the availability of yachts to be considered, we felt that this week before Pentecost will after all be the most suitable (the alternative would have been in early April with the obvious disadvantage of the colder weather). Finally, we had to find and set one date and hope that this will not bring too much trouble to your private engagements during that time.

We can't wait for ECC 2005 and take it from the overwhelming amount of responses we have received already that are looking forward to next year as well...
